Step One: Download the National

## **Important to Know:**

In Texas, there is no online registration available

Deadlines: Must be postmarked 30 days before Election Day.

In person registration deadline: 30 days before Election Day

Often, there will be voter drives where you can register to vote. Bring that ticket to the voting booths!

Absentee ballots are available for 65+, disabilities, travel, or in jail. Check vote.org

Keep track of election sites hours, current legislation, and plan ahead!
