

# HOW WHERE WHEN DO WE VOTE?

- Voting happens every year for different government offices. , called on-cycle or off-cycle years. On-cycle years are even years, with the most grandeur elections every four years. These elections will include the presidential, vice presidential, and congressional seats.

- Congressional seats, which includes both the Senate and the House of Representatives, are up for reelection during mid-term years, and may be staggered depending on the seat. For the senate position, a seat lasts six years, while for a representative, two.
